Footnotes

DEW DETIME dueled early while two wide, angled off the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held in the final stages. JEFF THE CLOCKER was unhurried early, fanned into the eight path in the turn then rallied widest in the stretch and just missed at the wire. BE RICH dueled early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. SISSY BOY stalked the pace early while four wide, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. KATZMETIC chased the pace early, fanned into the seven path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. G AREYOUKIDDING was squeezed back at the start, swung into the six path in the turn and improved position. FLAT OUT RICH vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. TIME TO GETIT tracked the pace early while five wide, angled into the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. COME SOON (URU) was done early. SUNSHINE BOI was always outrun.
