MELLOW FELLOW tracked the pace early, swung into the six path in the far turn while making the bid then battled back late in the drive and edged past the leader at the wire. COUNT ON SILVER was bumped at the start then stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn then drew clear in the stretch but shortened in the final sixteenth and was caught at the wire. JOY TO THE KING chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. INDIANA CHARLIE trailed the field early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. BAHAMIAN RUM broke out at the start then was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. LITTLE BOY LOST set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch. GO JACK GO was done early.
