SUDDENLY PERFECT unhurried three wide, advanced in that path on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished well to be clear late. SIR JOCK within striking distance four wide, moved up after a half, gained a short lead on the second turn and held on gamely for the place. WORKINONTHRAILROAD alternated for the lead off the inside, battled into the final furlong and weakened. WON HAPPY BACHELOR unprepared for the start, was outrun four wide, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. CHILLINESS reserved four wide, lacked a closing bid. NAFASS within striking distance off the rail, moved out to the four path on the second turn, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. EL BOMBA angled out to be five wide early, never threatened. CABAZON outrun early six wide, could not menace. SCORPION GO NORTH within striking distance 3 wide, faded. REGAL STORM behind the leaders in the three path, moved out a bit for the second turn and gave way. FIRST MOVEMENT alternated for the lead three wide and stopped. ROMNEY

MARSH was outrun.
