BIG RED RANGER within striking distance three wide, angled out for the drive and closed well to win going away. NEVER THERE set a pressured pace near the rail and held on for the place. GREELEY'S VOICE forced the pace off the inside and weakened. TIME TO PLAY prompted the pace three wide and also weakened. FIESTA TEXAS behind the leaders four wide, lacked a closing bid. WESTERN BANDIT outrun early, could not menace. UPTON PARK within striking distance, raced five wide into the turn and tired. SILVER ZEPHYR was no threat four wide.
