OFFICER ROCKET (GB) settled saving ground, slipped through to launch his bid, reeled in the leaders inside the sixteenth marker and drew clear. ROUSE THE CAT set the pressured pace off of the inside, shook clear through the turn, drifted out a bit under left handed urging in the drive, bumped with GOLDEN COUNTRY in the shadow of the wire and was unable to resist the winner. GOLDEN COUNTRY stalked the pace three wide, made his bid leaving the turn, was getting to ROUSE THE CAT steadily, bumped with that one late and settled for a minor award. DARLING MON settled in hand, came five wide to make a late rally and improved his position through the stretch. WAIT ON TATE was unhurried into stride, made a steady advance circling eight wide but failed to seriously threaten. BIG GLEN settled in the second flight, angled out to make a mild rally six wide but was never a factor. GODOLPHIN GRAY angled in to

save ground, made a belated gain entering the stretch but passed only his tiring rivals. TIMBUCTO pressed the pace along the inside to the stretch and tired. WILLIAM TELL chased the pace four wide for a half and dropped out. FUTURE PROSPECT prompted the pace three wide to the turn and retreated. MY PRIVATE LAKE was hustled along between horses for a half and faltered. JUNIOR COLLEGE settled in the back of the pack, was taken up entering the stretch, eased to the wire and walked off. The jockey of GOLDEN COUNTRY lodged an objection against ROUSE THE CAT for alleged interference in deep stretch, but following the review the Stewards made no change to the order of finish.
