SAILORS PASTTIME was bumped then briefly bobbed at the start, settled off the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field late. GRAND AFFAIR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. BLUE DIABLO was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. SUNNYWAY was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late. QUEEN GRACIE bobbed at the start, while on the inside into the turn and moved up in the stretch. SHARMONA pressed the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. DAILY STAR tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. BELIEVE IT HONEY was never involved. MRS. STEVE showed little. AIN'T BEHAVIN' broke awkwardly from the gate then was rushed up and eventually spent.
