Footnotes

CRYPTO KATE, well placed early while lightly rated between foes four wide, pressed front-running KAT KAN DANCE into the stretch, took over at the sixteenth pole and was hard ridden the remainder. LITTLE IRISH GIRL, unhurried early and five or six wide throughout, followed the winner outside into the stretch and wasn't good enough. NASTY ICE settled soon after the start, reached contention at the far turn when the leaders bunched, came out eight or nine wide for the drive but lacked a serious late response. KAT CAN DANCE gained a slim lead near the inside early, went along under careful handling, made the pace into deep stretch and faltered. TEJANO'S ECHO settled in a striking position three or four wide, raced forwardly into the stretch and came up empty. CLEAR DENIAL, checked in behind the leaders approaching the first turn, saved ground, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch, angled between rivals four or five wide for the drive and flattened out the last eighth. CERTIFIED APPROVAL stalked the pace five wide to the stretch and tired.
