Footnotes

CARSON CITY MADAME gained a slim lead early while dueling with CONTRY MARQUET, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and widened under energetic handling. RICH AND HAPPY stalked the winner four wide into the stretch and couldn't menace in the drive as second best. JUNIPER RIDGE broke awkwardly, was checked, then not a serious threat while improving position. RUNNING PAM, outsprinted early, came out eight or nine wide for the drive, improved position but couldn't menace. OLIVE DRAB, outrun until the stretch, also improved position while not a threat. AMY'S ARCHANGEL, in contention into the lane, flattened out when the test came. CLASSY CON, sluggish to start, failed to reach contention. OSTRICH BOOTS raced forwardly inside into the stretch and tired. CORA'S RIB faded approaching the stretch. COUNTRY MARQUET eased off the rail early to press CARSON CITY MADAME, continued forwardly until the stretch and tired.
