DANCING MISSILE sprinted clear early, worked his way to the inside, shook off SOLD TO WALLSTREET concluding the turn, then held PERSONAL FIRST safe under steady handling. PERSONAL FIRST, never far back and racing near the inside throughout, loomed a solid threat from the rail through the drive but wasn't good enough. SOLD TO WALLSTREET tracked the winner from early on while three or four wide, was just off DANCING MISSLE for the drive but came up empty. LUCKY BALDWIN, within easy striking distance while stalking the leaders four or five wide, was unable to muster a closing account. WILLOWBROOK LANE, a bit edgy in the gate prior to the start, broke in the air, reached contention near the inside concluding the turn, angled out a bit but couldn't offer a closing threat. TESTIFY bobbled after the start and failed to rally. LITTLE LEE tired early and was seven wide in the stretch run. ELI LILLIPUT was outrun.
