STRATOS ranged up six wide for a contending position, reeled in the leader through the turn, assumed command and quickly drew clear. STAN THE TAP MAN made a middle move five wide, opened clear after a half, was unable to resist the winner but continued on fairly well to hold the place. KENNESSEY made a long drive circling six wide and was along for the show. UNO DUCKSY was unhurried into stride, angled out six wide to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. LORD DUBAI pressed the pace three wide, but weakened from between horses leaving the turn and faded. POUND THE ROCK was unhurried early, made a belated gain seven wide but was never a factor. TRIP NORTH dueled for the lead three wide to the stretch and tired. MOTOWN BLUES passed only his tiring rivals. HAPPY OLIVE pressed the pace along the inside, but faltered leaving the turn and dropped out. MR. BRUTUS dueled for the lead two wide but stopped before going a half. MOVIE LEGEND trailed.
