Footnotes

CABAZON made a middle move four wide, assumed command after a half, was kept to task and drew away to score with something left. SPARK OF HUMOR rushed to contention five wide, was no match for the winner but finished fairly well to hold the place. MR. CHAMP was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide to make a late rally and was along for the show. CHASING THE CROWN contended between horses three deep, dropped off of the pace and angled in leaving the second turn, came again with a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. BALLACOLLA settled in hand, bid between horses four wide leaving the three-eighths pole, but flattened out entering the stretch and faded. STORMY ATLANTIS saved ground to no avail. MONK set the pressured pace three wide, was headed after a half, continued on willingly to the final furlong and dropped out. DANASLAM chased the pace three wide, but faltered from between horses leaving the second turn and faded. BERRY'S PRIDE vied for the lead between horses for a half, stopped and was distanced through the stretch.
