MICHELLEMYBELLE set slow fractions, was well rated, mildly encouraged eighth pole, won ridden out. CALLSTAR was well placed, rallied gamely quarter pole, closed willingly, but lacked a late response. ELLE CLIPPER was well placed, rallied, while saving ground, then flattened out. BRING IT NOW was well placed, had a mild late rally, but failed to sustain a bid. WEEKEND IN MANILA stalked the pace, rallied 2nd turn, but then hung. THEYRPLAYINOURSONG was void of early speed, passed tiring rivals, was no factor. COLE CODE was no threat, showed little. DYNA RUTH stalked the pace, rallied, but flattened out second turn. VI BELLE TWO was no threat, ran evenly with no rally. BOUNDING STORM failed to menace.
