TIGON vied for the lead off the inside, took over after a half, drew off and stayed clear under steady urging. OTHER LADY four wide early when within striking distance, angled in on the backstretch, raced in the two path on the second turn, angled out for the drive and lodged a mild bid for the place. WRAPPER close up early along the inside, dropped back a bit before a half then had no late bid. MAMA'S TUNE contested the early pace along the inside and tired. ENJOYTHE AFTERNOON outrun early, raced three wide out of the second turn and could not threaten. TIMESWEPT forwardly placed, raced in the four path on the second turn and tired. ENJOYABLE steadied early in traffic where the saddle slipped, held on well for five furlongs, faded badly and was outdistanced.
