KORBYN GOLD vied for the lead in the four path, took over after a half and increased his lead under steady urging. GENERAL PURPOSE forwardly placed five wide, lodged a mild bid for the place. FLAMING GLORY forced the pace three wide and tired. DUTY ROSTER outrun early, raced in the six path on the turn and made a belated bid outside. HESABLUMIN reserved early while within striking distance, moved up in the six path on the turn but could not sustain the bid. WINZALOT lost his footing a bit at the start, recovered to race within striking distance four wide but tired. CUB'S POWER behind the leaders while off the inside, faded. DIDYAGETITDONE was outrun.
