**Footnotes**

SCAT CAT FEVER set the pace off the inside, raced near the rail on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. SILVER STEF outrun early, made a run four wide on the second turn, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch, lacked a further bid but was clearly second best. JANICE SUE unprepared at the start, was outrun to the stretch and rallied belatedly. LITTLE NIBLETS stumbled at the start, was reserved early, came out four wide into the stretch and could not threaten. BENTLEY DANIELLE behind the leaders three wide, tired. MAMA DECIDES unhurried off the inside, failed to respond in the stretch. RIVA'S DISPUTE closest to the pace inside, faded. SWEET KITTY CAT was outrun. MIDNITE KATE within striking distance for a half four wide, stopped. SAGUARO took up along the inside on the first turn, took up again on the second turn when rallying along the inside then dropped back quickly and was outdistanced. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE TRAINER OF SAGUARO AGAINST THE RIDER OF MAMA DECIDES FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE SECOND TURN WAS NOT ALLOWED.
