BIG FLIRT reserved three wide, angled out a bit on the turn, made a bold move to the lead after a half and drew off in the drive. PICTURAL behind the leaders, raced in the five path on the turn and lodged a mild bid for the place. TRASH TO TREASURE outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and improved his position while no threat. IRVING RULES vied for the lead off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. YANKEE CAREER forced the pace in the three path, stayed on to the final quarter and faded. MITCH'S TWO BELOW outrun to the stretch, was no threat. TANNER ME BOY close up while off the inside, gave way. CLIFF'S BEST BET six wide on the turn, could not menace. MAD AFTERSHOCK was through early. NIMO forced the early pace between rivals, raced four wide on the turn and stopped.
