Footnotes

SLEDGE wide early, made a four wide run after a half, took over entering the stretch and lasted late. TRIPLE PLAY KITTEN reserved along the inside, moved off the rail on the backstretch, angled back to the inside with three furlongs to go, came to the outside for the drive and closed well but missed. HI TORREE within striking distance along the inside, angled out for the drive, drifted in in midstretch, was straightened but hung. SIN CARA outrun for five furlongs, was four wide on the second turn and could not threaten. NORTHERN EMPIRE vied for the lead three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. DAKOTA FRED five wide midway through the first turn, steadied entering the backstretch when attempting to bear in, recovered but was no threat late. LORD UNBRIDLED with the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. CUCO TREJO steadied on the first turn and dropped back, bore out approaching the stretch and was outrun.
