Footnotes

TOWN QUEEN moved up soon after the start to force the pace four or five wide while between rivals, gained a slight advantage just prior to going a half, went along under careful rating, then proved clearly best under strong handling. SUDDENLY GONE, within easy striking distance while tracking the leaders four or five wide, made a menacing run into the upper stretch, angled inside TOWN QUEEN in the final furlong and saved second. GAL ON THE GO, leaned in bumping with THERE RUNS HATTIE at the break, was checked soon after, settled in behind horses, eased out to make a sweeping run six wide approaching the final quarter, loomed prominently outside the winner for the last eighth but failed to sustain the needed momentum. THERE RUNS HATTIE, bumped at the start by GAL ON THE GO, reached contention upon going six furlongs while near the inside between foes but flattened out when straightened for the drive. SWEETWATER PROMISE, outrun to the far turn, wasn't able to menace while improving position. SEVEN FOUR SEVEN, nicely placed near the inside for six furlongs, gradually weakened thereafter. WILD KANDACE gained the lead near the inside early, showed the way for almost a half and weakened steadily. DANGEROUS GIRL, sluggish to begin and checked, never menaced. BEAUCHAMP POINT faded upon going a half. PERSIMMON RIDGE chased the leaders from early on while four or five wide, moved with the winner while outside that one leaving the backstretch and was finished upon going six furlongs.
