AZIDISCOUNT vied for the early lead three wide, moved in to the two path on the second turn and wore down off OFF ON A TANGENT late. OFF ON A TANGENT alternated for the lead along the inside and held on gamely to just miss. ONE MORE MOONDANCE forwardly placed off the inside, lacked a closing bid. REITO PEITO reserved early, moved to a challenging position four wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. INTREPID QUEEN close up early along the inside, dropped back on the backstretch then was no late threat. HOOSYER KHARMA prompted the pace three wide, challenged on the backstretch, gained a short lead before a half, held on well to the stretch and tired. ANGELIC LIGHT within striking distance, moved five wide with three furlongs to go and gave way. NATIVE FEVER never far back four wide, stopped.
