SAINTLY LOOK angled in early when outrun, advanced in the two path on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished fast to win going away. SGT. BERT behind the leaders three wide, angled out for the drive and lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. PRIVATE HORDE vied for the lead off the inside, took over in midstretch but faltered late. YUCATAN alternated for the lead three wide and weakened late. OVERLORD (AUS) outrun early, saved ground on the turn then lacked a closing bid. MY LORD reserved early, raced four wide with three furlongs to go and was no real threat. FIRE SLAM within striking distance off the inside, tired. MONTSTAR forced the pace in the four path and gave way. SLEW'S SAGA could not menace. CATLAUNCH forwardly placed from the outset, drifted five wide with three furlongs to go and faded. MUNA was outrun.
