Footnotes

BLUE DANGER sluggish at the start, made a run seven wide on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and edged off late. SHARP DANCER vied for the lead off the inside, took over on the turn and held on gamely in the drive. BO'S SHEPARD in tight early, raced behind the leaders along the inside and lacked the needed closing bid. EL MILAGRO SECRETO within striking distance four wide, angled out a bit for the drive but lacked a rally. CLOUDY VISION broke slowly, was outrun to the stretch, angled to the outside and rallied belatedly. READY SET WHOA forced the pace from the start, raced six wide into the turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. CONTRAPUNTAL vied for the lead off the inside but was through after a half. LEGATUS prompted the pace from the outset, raced five wide into the turn and faded in the stretch. TRACK COACH pressed the pace four wide and gave way. CICATRIZ with the leader early in the three path, stopped.
