INFLATION TARGET disputed the pace toward the inside, kicked clear on the turn, was kept to task and edged away. BIG ROYAL DEAL vied for the lead four wide, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. LUIGI P broke slow, moved up between horses, angled out entering the stretch but failed to make headway through the drive. ELUSIVE MALE settled saving ground, got through and finished with a mild rally. RED ILLUSION contended toward the inside through the turn, drifted out a bit entering the stretch but went evenly through the lane. UR UP ZIP hopped at the start, was allowed to settle and failed to threaten. SERVICE DUTY HONOR broke slow, shifted to the outside, went wide throughout and was never a factor. HARLAN'S HALO was through early.
