SEAFARING MAN stalked the early speed, moved out three wide for a drive around the final turn, took command nearing the upper stretch and held on gamely. SHADY VALLEY wrested command after the opening mile, battled while outside IMPERIAL GOLD (NZ) to the final turn, was between foes around the final turn, then was unable to match the winners drive while second best. MON VILLEZ (FR) raced from between foes early, was never far back but lacked a late response. IMPERIAL GOLD (NZ) vied for the lead, battled while inside around the final turn and soon gave way. INDISPENSABLE raced from behind the field while unhurried and never threatened. GRITTY SANDIE was well rated from the early stages, moved up along the outside to reach contention around the final turn, then lost rider shortly after the twelfth fence. ALL RACES AT TRYON RACE COURSE ARE HAND TIMED.
