MISS TABLE TALK well placed along the inside, challenged for the lead between foes leaving the furlong grounds then bested TOASTIE'S CROWN. The latter lodged a bid on the turn and finished willingly while being steadied some at the wire. SADIEISOFINE posted the early fractions and weakened. AEROSAL was gaining some late along the inside. ROBINA lodged a bid outside on the turn and tired in the drive. OLYMPIC STAGE lacked a rally. SUPERCILIOUS MISS lacked a bid. PREPPY SQUAW raced five wide turning for home and offered little in the drive. LIGHT UP THE TOTE broke awkwardly. SASSY CAT unseated the rider at the gate and ran loose briefly in the chute, was bumped at the start then gave way nearing the lane. A claim of foul by the rider of TOASTIE'S CROWN against the winner for interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
