Footnotes

COCONINO unruly briefly during the post parade saved ground and dueled for the lead, drew clear on the second then responded well in the drive and held a rival safe through the late stages. CRANTINI well placed early, lodged a bid on the final turn and finished gamely. CHOW MIEN lodged a bid outside on the second turn, raced in the four path entering the lane and lacked the needed late response. SEEKITANA moved four wide for the drive and lacked the needed rally. NOBLE RULE saved ground and chased in midstretch then needed more. RED PEN LETTER saved ground and lacked a rally. LADY'S TASTE inside into the far turn, raced just off the rail turning for home and weakened in the drive. OUR KITTEN dueled outside a rival to the far turn and gave way then faded through the lane.
