Footnotes

STORM'S RISEN was unhurried early, bid between horses on the far turn, dueled through the stretch and prevailed. PETER'S CHARITY was rated early while close to the pace, bid between horses on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. SHIMMY CAT challenged five wide on the second turn, dueled for the lead, went willingly to the wire and was outfinished. DON'T SAY THAT was unhurried early, angled out on the far turn, bid between horses, angled in upper stretch, bid rail, was blocked and lost his chance. HEAVENLY HONOR pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, angled out top of stretch and leveled off. MR. DUDE was not a factor. CODE AMOUR was hustled along to set a pressured pace, had the rider check on the turn and gave way. MOWGLI showed speed to the second turn and tired. The stewards posted an inquiry regarding the stretch run. No change was made.
