FORSMAN vied for the lead outside a rival then edged clear in the drive. DR. OLIVER broke a bit awkwardly, saved ground on the turn and finished willingly. MAKACK saved ground and battled for the lead then weakened late. WOBBLY FELLOW close up into the turn while three wide, lacked the needed closing response. LINE OF CREDIT was asked for run on the turn and lacked the needed late response. DANTE'S GULCH raced near the inside and lacked the needed response. YANKEE STORM saved ground and lacked a bid. D' WEATHERMAN lacked a rally. RUM AND EARL raced six wide into the lane and tired. JAYBOB stumbled at the start, lacked a rally and raced seven wide into the stretch.
