CALEB BOY vied two across, inched away in late stretch and proved best. EL VIC vied inside to late stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner. DIRECT CONNECT raced close to the pace, went four wide entering the stretch and prevailed for show. JOE'S CANNON stalked the pace inside, eased out on the turn, bid three wide and was outnodded for third. RENEGADE CIELO saved ground while racing within striking distance but lacked the needed late rally. BUCK'S BLUSH was never far back, failed to rally and did not menace. FAVORITE MEETING was outrun. WARREN'S JACK V. was not a factor.
