Footnotes

MATAMOR stumbled at the start then dropped back through the opening stages to trail, raced just off the inside turning for home, advanced through traffic and was along in time. WANTED POSTER moved to the front three wide on the turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and held well to the wire. PICO PETE raced three wide and between rivals passing the quarter pole, chased and needed more late. SILVER DAYBREAK vied for the early lead, saved ground and pressed then was not good enough. SKID raced just off the inside on the turn, eased out some in midstretch then was gaining late. GOING YARD four wide passing the quarter pole, chased and needed more late. GELFAND raced four wide on the turn and lacked the needed rally while making up some ground late. SRIRACHA was near the inside on the turn and lacked a response. GOLDEN WARRIOR well placed early, saved ground and lacked a bid. GULCHEN saved ground and lacked a rally. MAGIC PARTNER vied for the lead, raced between rivals on the turn and weakened in the drive. POET'S COVE raced outside into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and tired.
