IT'S NOT OVER YET advanced along the rail, slipping thru at the quarter, gained a short lead at the eighth pole and held off a fast closing foe to prevail. FLYING STRAWBERRY was unhurried early, placed a bid inside at the top of the stretch, angled out at the eighth pole and found his best stride late when clear. COMIN' ATCHA was hustled away to set a pressured early pace racing off the rail, was challenged nearing the eighth pole, came up empty in the drive but held the show. ANOTHER QUICKIE was void of early speed, rallied nearing the quarter pole, angled out six wide into the stretch, was steadied slightly when a foe crossed his path mid stretch and finished showing late interest. FASTWELL was outrun early, the rider lost his whip nearing the half, then went six wide in the stretch passing tiring foes. FLOORFIRE was unhurried early, circled the field into the stretch placing a brief bid then weakened. DIXIE GENTLEMAN was close in the early going then faded. RED IMAGE pressed the early pace from the outside then gave way.
