IN STORMS WAY four wide early, advanced five wide into the far turn and reached the front on the final bend, battled through the lane then finished gamely to prevail. SHENADOAH trailed early, advanced rounding the final turn and raced four wide into the stretch and finished gamely. IRONSIDES advanced four wide and between rivals leaving the backstretch and reached the front between calls, raced along the inside turning for home and battled then yielded nearing the wire. CASA MIA was steadied briefly entering the far turn, raced along the inside into the lane and was between foes nearing the eighth pole and finished willingly. SEANSOLBEAN challenged for the lead inside nearing the far turn and led briefly then tired in the drive. TIZZY MCKEE five wide into the clubhouse turn, raced between foes leaving the backstretch and chased then weakened through the lane. BUCK'S STRIDE set the early pace and gave way on the final turn.
