KELEN SCORES raced mid pack, offered a mild four wide bid to earn place while no match for the winner. HONEST EARNIE was crowded at the start, vied two across to the turn, flattened out but held safely for show. MARLEAU saved ground mid pack and lacked a bid. WOBBLY FELLOW saved ground, got through along the rail entering the stretch and came up empty. WEST FORTY was crowded at the start, went five wide leaving the turn and had nothing left for the drive. YANKEE STORM was outrun. ROJO RED broke out, vied inside to the turn, stopped and was eased. SHARP SONG distanced the field.
