DIAMOND DAN moved to the front on the turn, held a narrow advantage in midstretch then held gamely to the wire. BARBARIC up close early outside, lodged a three wide bid turning for home and finished gamely. DOHNSTER came out at the start bumping a rival then bumped in tight between foes, saved ground on the turn and finished gamely outside. MICHAELS JILA broke alertly and set the early pace, saved ground and stayed on willingly while not good enough. EDUARDO bumped at the start, was steadied on the turn then lacked a stretch bid. HEISMAN U was bumped at the start and lacked a rally. SHARK CITY was steadied on the turn getting out then raced wide. FIGHTING CITY HALL was outrun and eased up late. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the start but no change was made.
