VISIBLE MARQ pressed the pace, challenged two across, drew off on the turn, was under pressure through the stretch and held on gamely. ROCKET TRAIN was unhurried early, advanced inside to challenge for the lead, went willingly to the wire but couldn't gain on the winner. BUFF DADDY was unhurried early, went five wide entering the stretch and finished well to earn show. TWO TURNS was slow early, advanced to the turn, bid off the rail to loom a threat but didn't have enough late. NORTHERN THUNDER was slow early, went eight wide in the drive and failed to rally. SHOWTIME DON improved position in an even effort. TENATIOUS SPIRIT set a pressured pace, tired into the turn and gave way. NOTIME TO BADINAGE was through after a half. HUNTER KANE raced wide and was through after a half. MACHO QUITO was never far back, tired after a half and gave way.
