GIACOMO GIRL rushed to the lead in the run to the turn, maintained the margin throughout and held sway under right-handed urging. DEPUTY INNOVATOR vied for the early lead then chased the winner throughout and held on well. MAGGIEREDVANENTUNE was just off the leaders to the turn, was four wide into the stretch, moved back to the inside inside the furlong grounds and finished willingly late. PLUS ULTRA broke well then bore out after the start and fell back, was straightened, moved up while four wide near the quarter pole then lacked a solid stretch bid. CELAYA'S PRIZE vied for the early lead from along the rail then tired through the stretch. OZINGA was a bit fractious behind the gate before loading then fell back after the start and lacked a rally. TICKLE ME TWICE forced the pace into the turn, took the two path on the turn and tired in the stretch.
