Footnotes

NIPSYS REAL JOY pressed the pace inside while boxed in, got through along the rail leaving the turn, dueled past the eighth pole, inched away and held off SATIN CREATION. SATIN CREATION was unhurried early, angled out on the turn, bid five wide, closed steadily and gained late. THELIFE OF THE PARTY set a pressured pace while racing inside, dueled between horses stretch, was outclosed and just lasted for show. COUNTDOWN QUEEN saved ground, was taken back a bit entering the second turn, bid along the rail, finished well and just missed for third. ROLLIN STOCK pressed the pace three across, went four wide entering the stretch, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. COLONY QUEEN pressed the pace two across, dueled three across through the stretch and faltered near the sixteenth pole. DR. JESS JR stalked the pace and lacked the needed late response.
