Footnotes

HECTOR raced close to the pace, rallied into the turn, assumed command, drew off for a clear lead and held well under urging. MIGHTY BUCK raced outside, challenged four across on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, fell back, continued willingly once straightened and narrowed the gap. DESERT TRAIN challenged three wide between horses on the turn, fell back, continued to close, couldn't gain ground but was safe for show. PEAKNATACAT raced between horses to the backstretch, fell back to stalk, stayed close, angled out in the upper stretch, bid six wide but failed to gain. CASE SETTLED assumed command along the backstretch, drew clear, led to the turn and flattened out. TALYOR vied inside early, fell back and was through after a half. MATTY O'KEEFE was steadied along the rail into the first turn, raced in the back and failed to rally. CASH RECEIPT was fractious in the gate, raced wide, advanced to the second turn but had nothing left for the drive.
