SNUGGS AND KISSES set a pressured pace, drew clear into the turn and extended her lead through the stretch under steady left handed urging. HARD SEVEN stalked the pace, went four wide entering the stretch, couldn't gain ground and was no match for the winner. CATCH LORRAINE veered out at the start, pressed the pace, fell back on the turn, continued under urging and got up late for show. QUEEN GREELEY was crowded at the start, stalked the pace, bid along the rail on the turn to loom a threat, leveled off and was caught for third. DISTURBINGLY HOT lagged early, went seven wide in the drive and failed to menace. BLUE MOON HIGH raced in the middle of the pack, lacked a stretch response and dropped back. ELVIES LANE was not a factor.
