EIGHT AND TWO was unhurried early racing off the rail, drifted out into the stretch three wide and gained the place but was no match for the winner. HEIDI ONE was off slow early racing off the rail, vied in the stretch and was up for the show. GOODTIMESRCOMING pressed the early pace from the outside, then tired and gave way. SURELY MAE was forwardly placed three wide then faded. COUP DE FOU DRE raced wide mid pack then retreated. SWIMSEY trailed the field and was always outrun.
