GRANDPA ROY advanced between rivals on the backstretch and challenged for the lead, raced on near even terms turning for home then was no match late while second best. TWOWAY HARD TEN broke in, drifted wide into the clubhouse turn, raced well placed outside and lacked the needed response. THATS WHY WE WENT rank early, was outrun into the lane then offered a belated gain. SANDERS broke out some, was hung wide into the first turn, raced near the inside into the lane and lacked the needed bid. BIG CRESCENDO broke in, prompted the early issue, remained a factor to the lane and tired. ISKANDER advanced inside into the far turn then had little left entering the lane. CANARD lacked a rally. MR. MICK bumped at the start, saved ground turning for home and lacked a bid. ROSES 'N RAINBOWS broke slowly, chased early and weakened.
