PALMERTON was kept close inside, waited for room on the bend, got through three wide leaving the turn, responded to mostly hand urging to gain the lead leaving the sixteenth marker then drew clear under a mild drive. CAPTAIN'S MANEUVER disputed the pace outside ROCKY BAR through the early going, drew clear briefly in the lane, lugged in some near the eighth pole, tried hard but wore down late. ROCKY BAR set a pressured pace inside through the early going but flattened out in the lane. UNCLE PUNK void of speed outside the rest, was angled in on the turn and only passed tired ones the last eighth while lugging in. AUGUSTAN raced evenly three to five wide. JETSON broke alertly, was soon chasing ROCKY BAR and CAPTAIN'S MANEUVER from outside, floated out some into the stretch and faltered for the drive. HERO'S PLEASURE always outside, moved to the rail into the turn, lacked a stretch response and was steadied late when UNCLE PUNK took his path nearing the wire.
