Footnotes

LASTING CASH lodged a four wide bid on the final turn, chased through the lane and finished steadily to prevail. SUNNY COMMANDER up close early, moved to the front between rivals on the final turn and drew clear, widened then yielded in the drive. FORTYFIVEJEWELS advanced nearing the top of the lane, moved four wide into the stretch and was best of the rest. DIAMOND ICE GIRL raced five wide into the lane and lacked the needed bid. WIND DIAL stumbled at the start and bumped, prompted the issue, moved to the front briefly between calls passing the three-eighths pole then tired through the lane. HUM ALONG LIL saved ground while well placed, raced between foes passing the quarter pole and tired through the stretch. FIFTY K angled inside early, saved ground into the far turn and weakened. BLASTER stumbled at the start, set the early pace while headstrong then gave way nearing the top of the lane.
