WARONTHEHOMEFRONT raced mid pack, eased out at the top of the lane, bid four wide, assumed command near the eighth pole and inched clear. ADRIATIC MOON was checked hard into the first turn, checked again mid turn, saved ground in the back, went nine wide at the top of the lane, found his best stride late and was gaining ground. MR. CACHT (ARG) vied to mid stretch, was unable to sustain his bid but held for show. FREE BEER vied inside to mid stretch and yielded grudgingly. ST PATRICKS APPEAL raced in the middle of the pack, went five wide in the drive and lacked the needed late response. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP pressed the pace, challenged three across on the turn, had nothing left and gave way. SPECTACULARTOP was not a factor. SOME KINDA BOY was hustled along to vie between horses, was through after a half and tired. BATTLE SCHOOL was in tight into the first turn, moved up outside along the backstretch to challenge four wide on the turn and stopped.
