Footnotes

MOONLIT MADDIE rated outside, went for the lead three wide on the second turn, got the advantage midstretch, battled gamely the final furlongs and held on. DARTING DOT pressed ASPEN HILL from just outside, also made her move on the second turn, never relented two wide in the lane but had to settle for second best. NO TURBULENCE moved up outside DARTING DOT on the backstretch to be well placed, took the second turn four wide, was slow to respond in the stretch but closed the gap late. IMPERATRIZ RAFAELA (BRZ) too far back the first half mile, saved ground through the second turn, was angled out three wide for the stretch run, closed with a rush and just missed for third. DINNER AT LIDO'S trailed from off the rail, picked up her pace three to four wide through the second turn and showed a willingness to run late from outside. ASPEN HILL took the early lead, set the pace inside, was caught on the second turn, fought to hold on but weakened inside the final furlong. DIXIE WITCH well placed just off the rail, gave way on the second turn and raced evenly through the lane. ALLIE OHLEE broke first, gradually backed up inside, floated out into the second turn, proved unresponsive in the stretch, was eased late and walked off.
