STEP ASIDE CLYDE rallied into the second turn, assumed command, drew off and extended his lead while being ridden out. SKY TERRY set the pace, drew off into the turn, was outclosed, no match for the winner and just lasted for place. AWESTRIKE advanced inside, eased out for the drive, offered a mild bid and earned show. SAN GIUSEPPE bumped at the start, saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn and came up empty. COOPER'S STORM veered out at the start, went five wide on the first turn, stalked between horses and was through after a half. EXCESS BOOKS bumped at the start, pressed the pace, tired into the turn and faded from contention. DASHTIME broke in and was outrun. REKLESENDANGERMENT was not a factor. PHILOLOGY was carried out at the start, went six wide on the first turn, tired after a half, stopped and was not urged late.
