STRESSLESS saved ground on the turn, took the two path in upper stretch then finished well from the inside. WAVERLY GIRL chased the winner throughout and lacked a solid stretch bid. MISS VOYAGER broke alertly then settled some after the start then lacked a stretch bid. NAUGHTYLILHOTTIE raced between foes into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. MEGO took the three path on the turn and never seriously threatened. HALF GAITER saved ground to no avail. GRACIOUS HALO trailed throughout.
