GUMMY RUNNER drew clear into the clubhouse turn, showed the way to the lane and widened some in upper stretch then was all out to prevail. LEWDAGW N PARADISE never far back while saving ground, raced in the two path turning for home then finished gamely inside and just missed. SABINO STORM well placed and inside into the far turn, lacked the needed late response. VALID THOUGHTS tracked early inside, raced between rivals turning for home and weakened in the drive. AMBEKAY in good position early, raced three wide turning for home and tired in the drive. DRIVING RANGE saved ground and lacked a rally. MAKINYOURMARK raced in the three path passing the quarter pole and offered little in the drive. CALL FOR JUSTICE a bit restless in the gate, broke awkwardly then showed little. UNCONSTRAINED lacked a response. EXPECT ME broke a bit slowly and outside into the clubhouse turn, gave way entering the far turn and lost contact through the lane then was vanned off.
