BLUE CARACAL moved out on the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and finished gamely while up at the wire. SEVEN POINT ONE vied for the lead, saved ground and drew clear in the stretch then just failed to stay. MIKE'S TRIPPIN was angled inside into the turn, stayed on the rail for the drive and finished willingly while needing more late. TANGO MANGO vied for the lead between rivals and weakened late. WARREN'S BLVD. was bumped and stumbled at the start, chased five wide and lacked the needed stretch response. TWOWAY HARD TEN bumped at the start dropping back, raced six wide into the stretch and offered a mild stretch gain. LYDIA'S LEGACY vied for the early lead three wide and between rivals and weakened in the drive. GOTTA GETCHA stumbled at the start, saved ground and lacked a rally. EDMOND broke out, pressed four wide and between foes then was in tight late while weakening.
