CLASS FIVE RAPID was in tight entering the first turn, moved up along the backstretch to challenge between horses, assumed command on the turn, drew clear and held well in a driving finish. BALLESTERO raced wide early, got through along the rail on the second turn, eased out for the drive, closed well and was gaining late. SEARCHFORTHETRUTH raced mid pack, went six wide at the top of the stretch and finished well to earn show. SLEWS THE STANDARD set the pace to the second turn, weakened in the drive and fell back. ONERY DOLLARS was never far back, advanced to the stretch to get within striking distance, had little left and hung. YES HE'S A PISTOL was never far off the pace but failed to rally. CONDITIONAL was steadied on the first turn, moved up three wide between horses to loom a threat, tired and gave way. TWOFISTED pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. FRANK ROYAL (ARG) fell far back early and trailed the field.
