YVETT'S PRIDE vied for the early lead and drew clear on the backstretch, showed the way to the lane and widened passing the eighth pole then held a rival safe to the wire. BODACAT lodged a bid outside on the final turn and finished gamely. JACK'S ROMA vied early inside, moved just off the rail on the backstretch, was steadied heading into the far turn, moved out during the stretch run and came back on late. CASA O broke out some and three wide on the clubhouse turn, raced forwardly placed and lacked the needed response. FAVORITE MEETING tracked early, lodged a bid on the final turn and chased then weakened in the drive. HUNTIN A HALO broke out, saved ground and lacked a rally. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE saved ground to the far turn, raced three wide turning for home and lacked a bid. HAITIAN raced near the rail and lacked a rally.
